Kara will be with us every Monday and Tuesday and will continue to work with our infant students in the Winangali classroom in the mornings before combining with the primary students in the Ngurray room for our afternoon lessons.

Our Term 3 Small School's Hub Day was held on Tuesday. Hermidale and Marra Creek Public Schools joined us for a range of activities.
