Giilambone P&C AGM will be held this Friday, 15th March, at 2.30pm. All parents and community members are encouraged to attend.


There has been a decrease in the return of homework this year. Please ensure your child is completing their homework activities and returning it on Friday.

National Assessment Program - Literacy and Numeracy Information for parents and carers

- All students in Years 3, 5, 7 and 9 in Australia do NAPLAN tests in March each year.
- NAPLAN tests students' skills in reading, writing and maths.
- The test questions are presented in Standard Australian English dialect.
- Students read some of the questions and listen to others with headphones.
- The tests will get easier or harder, depending on how students are going in the
- test. Students do four different tests. The names of the four tests are:



- Students in Year 3 will do the Writing test using pencil and paper. Year 3 students will answer the other test questions on the computer.
- Students in Years 5, 7 and 9 will answer all their test questions on computers.
- Teachers will help students get ready for NAPLAN tests.

AUSTRALIAN CURRICULUM, ASSESSMENT AND REPORTING AUTHORITY

- Schools will get their students' results. The school will then give parents/carers a report showing their
- own child's results.
 Parents/carers can talk to the teacher about these results.
- NAPLAN shows how students are going all over Australia. People who work in the Australian Government, state and territory education authorities and schools use NAPLAN results. The results
- let them see which schools are doing well and which schools might need help.
